As we spoke over the phone, I do appreciate the offer you were giving me; however, I will bring this up to my manager to see if I can accept an offer like that. Like I've said before, I think it is a good opportunity for both us.

Here is the color values for a rich black.

C: 60%

M: 40%

Y: 40%

K: 100%

Total Ink usage: 240%

Keep in mind that you have to follow these color values to equally level out the inks on the presses. DO NOT put 100% on each color value (C100%, M100%, Y100%, K100%) because it is over-flood the print with ink and will cause a problem.
