

Mold Testing & Mold Inspection

MOLD testing is the process by which an Indoor Air Quality professional tests for mold in an indoor environment.

MOLD is everywhere in our environment. It is an important part of our ecosystem as it plays a major role in the decomposition of decaying plant matter. Mold testing is performed around the principle of comparative analysis. Having mold in an indoor environment in and of itself is not a problem. However, mold becomes a potential health problem when indoor concentrations reach levels far and above normal human exposure limits.

Mold can start to grow in as little as 24-48 hours after a moisture or water intrusion.

Symptoms of Toxic Mold Syndrome

The mycotoxins produced by toxic mold create environmentally toxic air that affects the body's myelin, depleting this important substance that covers the nerves. The nerves are exposed without protection and fail to function correctly. This affects essential components of the body, including: the immune system, the nervous system, the respiratory system, the skin, and the gastrointestinal system. When toxic mold causes neurological problems, it can be devastating to children since their brains and other organs are not fully developed.
